Given to a senior who is serving on a civic oriented organization (example: Mayor's Youth Council, student school board, Sons or Daughters of the American Revolution, student council, Polk County Conservation Youth Corps, National Honor Society, 4-H Teen Council in Polk County, American Legion Boys or Girls State, Iowa Youth Congress, etc.), preferably in a leadership role (chair, President, VP, etc.).
